

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION
of
CROWN PROVOST ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The undersigned, desiring to form an unincorporated nonprofit association, certify that:

- 1) The name of the association is the CROWN PROVOST ADVISORY COMMITTEE. Its abbreviation shall be CPAC. The name of the association was registered with the State of California and granted a certificate of registration by the Secretary of State on _____; Registration # _____.
- 2) The office of the association shall be located in Santa Cruz, California, at a place designated by the CPAC from time to time.
- 3) The CPAC is organized as a nonprofit association under Section 18000, et seq. of the California Corporations Code for common lawful purposes as stated in these ARTICLES and in the CPAC Bylaws, and is not organized primarily to operate a business for profit.
- 4) The CPAC is formed specifically for the purpose of fostering and supporting alumni-student engagement with the educational mission of Crown College (a college within the Santa Cruz campus of the University of California) so that current students at Crown can benefit by becoming a part of the larger Crown community that includes alumni and past faculty. The purpose of CPAC is to assist the Crown Provost in developing and sustaining support for programs, facilities and venues that enable current students to draw on the life and professional experiences of Crown College alumni to provide perspective and to enhance and enrich the intellectual, educational, social and work/life development of Crown students as they progress through their undergraduate years. CPAC will function also in assisting the Crown Provost in fostering and supporting activities that provide opportunities for Crown College alumni to re-engage and collaborate with fellow alumni in ways that strengthen and sustain the larger Crown community and its continuing commitment to the founding social and educational principles that made Crown College such an enriching undergraduate experience.
- 5) No part of the net earnings of the association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its Chair, officers or Committee members, or other private persons, except that the association shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for goods and services rendered or costs incurred in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Paragraph 4 above, and consistent with the Bylaws and other governing documents of the association.
- 6) No substantial part of the activities of the association shall be the carrying on of activities, or otherwise attempting to influence or participate in or intervene in (including the

publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. The association shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an association exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (IRC) or by an association, contributions to which are deductible under 170(c)(2) of the IRC (or corresponding future provisions).

- 7) The governing structures and principles of the CPAC and all other matters affecting its organization and operation shall be prescribed in the association's Bylaws. The association shall have the protections, power and authority to the fullest extent permitted by law to a California unincorporated nonprofit association.
- 8) Upon dissolution of the association, the CPAC shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the association, dispose of all of the assets of the association, if any, to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation exclusively for the direct benefit of Crown College. In the event of a merger involving the association the disposition shall be as directed by the merger agreement, with the intent that any such merger will be for the ultimate benefit of the students of Crown College.
